Approving to Update Statutory School Facility Fees Imposed on New Residential and Commercial/Industrial Construction Pursuant to Education Code 17620 and Government Code Section 65995

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees ("Board") of the Fallbrook Union High School District ("School District") will hold a Public Hearing at its Regular Meeting to be held on March 21, 2016 to allow for public comment prior to consideration of its reports titled "Residential Development School Fee Justification Study for [Abstract] School District" and "Commercial/Industrial Development School Fee Justification Study for [Abstract] School District" ("Fee Studies"), and consider adopting a resolution of the Board of the School District to update Statutory School Facility Fees Imposed on New Residential and Commercial/Industrial Construction Pursuant to Education Code Section 17620 and

Government Code Section 65995. The Fee Studies justifying such update, which are incorporated herein by this reference, are on file at the School District's offices, located 2234 South Stage Coach Lane, Fallbrook, CA 92028 and are available for public review from March 10, 2016 through March 21, 2016.

The Public Hearing of the School District, to be held March 21, 2016 will begin at 6:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as practicable, at the Fallbrook High School located at 2400 South Stage Coach Lane, Fallbrook, CA 92028. These matters will be considered at such time as this agenda item is considered by the Board of the School District.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board of Trustees of the Fallbrook Union High School District will adopt or decline to adopt Resolution No. 08-1516, Approval to Update Statutory School Facility Fees Imposed on New Residential and Commercial/Industrial Construction Pursuant to Education Code Section 17620 and Government Code Section 65995.

XII. ITEMS FROM THE FLOOR

Members of the audience who wish to distribute written information to the Board must give materials to the Board Secretary prior to the beginning of the meeting.

In order to conduct district business in an orderly and efficient manner, the Board requires that public presentations to the Board comply with the following procedures:

Individual speakers shall be allowed five minutes to address the Board on each agenda or non-agenda item. The Board shall limit the total time for public input on each agenda item to 20 minutes. With Board consent, the president may increase or decrease the time allowed for public presentation, depending on the topic and the number of persons wishing to be heard.

The Board shall give members of the public an opportunity to address the Board on any item of interest to the public that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Board during the Board's consideration of the item. (Education Code 35145.5, Government Code 54954.3)

At the time so designated on the agenda at a regular meeting, members of the public may bring before the Board matters that are not listed on the agenda. The Board shall take no action or discussion on any item not appearing on the posted agenda, except as authorized by law. (Education Code 35145.5, Government Code 54954.2)

Whenever a member of the public initiates specific complaints or charges against an employee, the Board president shall inform the complainant that in order to protect the employee's

right to adequate notice before a hearing of such complaints and charges, and also to preserve the ability of the Board to legally consider the complaints or charges in any subsequent evaluation of the employee, it is the policy of the Board to hear such complaints or charges in closed session unless otherwise requested by the employee pursuant to Government Code 54957. The Board President shall also encourage the complainant to file a complaint using the appropriate district complaint procedure.
