DEFINITION

Under the direction and supervision of the Teen Parent Director, the child care provider will assist in implementing and supervising the day to day care of the infants of the Teen Mothers and perform the following daily tasks:

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Manage the on campus nursery by:

- Providing infant care for the Teen Parents who have been enrolled by the Teen Parent Director.
- Daily accessing each infant; checking for health problems, checking with parents if there is enough food, diapers, infant's wipes, etc. for each child.
- Keeping a clean and sanitary nursery at all times, plus assigning teen parents to weekly 10-15 minute cleaning duties as needed in the nursery.
- Keeping daily attendance on infants and updating shot records as needed.
- Reporting to the Teen Parent Director any unusual marks, possible neglect and/or unusual parenting of an infant.
- Daily communication with Teen Parents, listening to their questions, concerns, and anxieties, being supportive with Teen Parents, encouraging them to continue their education, advising Teen Parents to talk to the Teen Parent Director and or Principal for problem solving advice.

Participation on field trips with Teen Parents is welcomed but not required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Equivalent to the completion of the twelfth grade.
- Proof of good health and ability to perform active/strenuous work with infants.
- Have a current CPR certificate. Three months will be allotted to attend a CPR class for certification
- Provider must have a TB test and fingerprint clearance.

DAILY HOURS

- 2 Childcare providers: 3.9 hours each Monday through Friday: morning session.
- 1 Childcare provider: 3hours Monday through Friday: afternoon session
